POSITION OF YUGOSLAVIA

DRAFT RESOLUTION

THE COUNCIL TAKES NOTE of the letter dated 29 September, 1961, from the Permanent Delegation of Yugoslavia, whereby Yugoslavia gave notice of its intention to withdraw from CERN under Article XII of the Convention, and that this withdrawal would normally have taken effect on 31 December, 1961,

TAKES NOTE of the statement by the Yugoslav Delegate at the Twentieth Session of Council,

RESOLVES that the letter of 29 September remain in suspense and that, if, before the session of the Council on 14 June, 1962, Yugoslavia decides to cancel the letter of 29 September, 1961, Yugoslavia shall be regarded as remaining and having remained continuously a Member State of CERN, but that if the Yugoslav Government notifies the Director-General before 14 June, 1962, that they wish the notice given in their letter of 29 September, 1961, to become effective, Yugoslavia shall be regarded as having ceased to be a Member of CERN on 31 December, 1961.
