RESOLUTION OF THE SCIENTIFIC POLICY COMMITTEE

ADDRESSED TO COUNCIL

At its meeting on 19 March 1975 the Scientific Policy Committee discussed the proposal* made by the Committee of Council concerning the future structure of CERN and the election of two Directors-General, Dr J.B. Adams and Professor L. Van Hove. It supports the solution proposed and is satisfied that the proposal is within the spirit of the Scientific Policy Committee's previous recommendations.

The Scientific Policy Committee considers that a final decision on the appointment of the Directors-General in the Council session of 21 March 1975 is of paramount importance to CERN. Any postponement would prove very harmful to the Organization.

This resolution was adopted unanimously by the Scientific Policy Committee.
